

INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUTHORS

1. Articles for publication in the Shinshu Medical Journal will be accepted only from members of the Shinshu Medical Society. In the case of collaborative work, all of the authors must be members of the Society.
2. Articles may be scientific reviews or commentaries, original research papers, recent news, brief communications, case reports, CPC reports, or reports on experimental techniques, etc.
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e. The title page should contain, in the following order, the title of the article, the names and affiliations of the authors, a list of no more than five keywords for indexing purposes, a short running title, the number of pages of text, the number of figures and tables, the required number of reprints (in red), and the corresponding author's name, contact address, and e-mail address. Any special requests to the editorial committee should be printed on a separately attached sheet.
